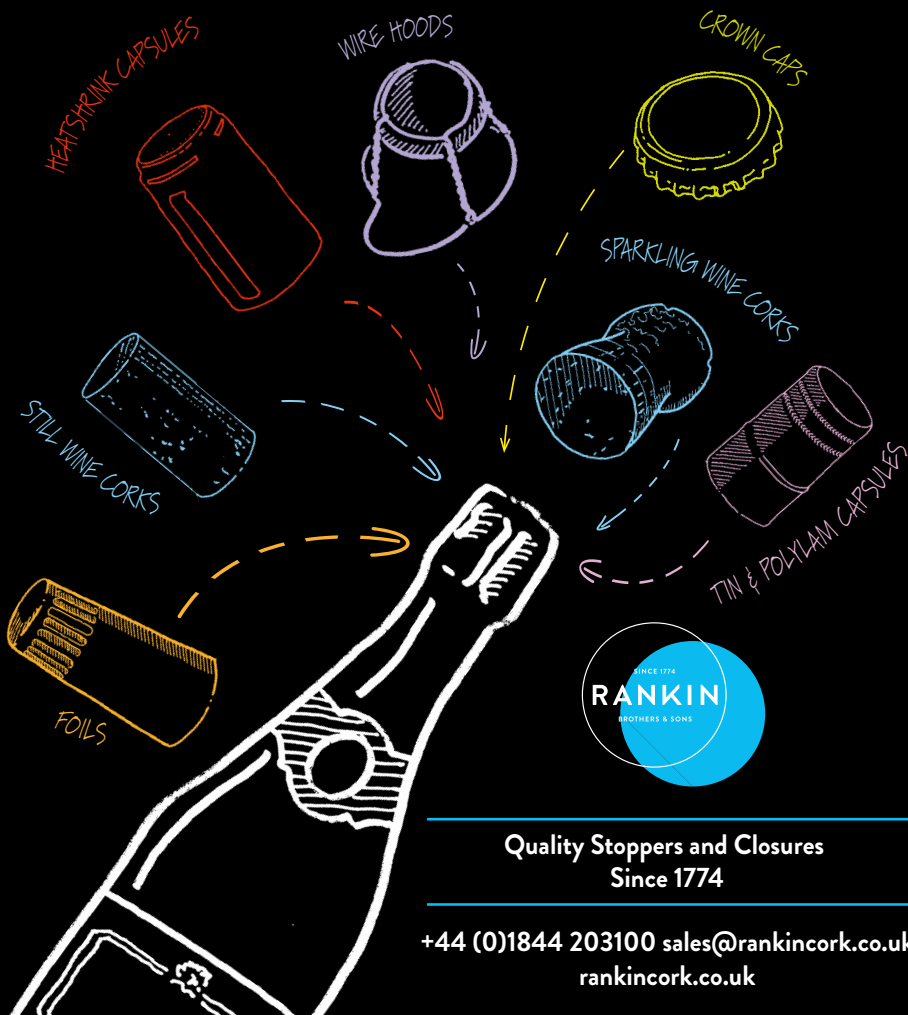

Notes from the Co-Chairs



"In a country with such a marginal climate as the UK it's incredibly challenging to produce world-class wines every year, even with the help of the more beneficial elements of climate change. The fact that our line-up of gold medals in 2023 included every vintage from 2013 to 2022 just shows how experienced our winemakers have become and how brilliant they are at teasing characterful wines out of even the most difficult of years. I'd also say that if the ability to produce age-worthy wines is the sign of a truly world-class wine region, based on our results this year, the UK can certainly stake its claim to that title too.

What's perhaps most satisfying about chairing this competition each year, beyond the sheer joy of being able to taste and compare so many of the UK's finest wines, is seeing new names appear on the list of medals. For a competition like this to have value, it needs to attract the best of the best, whether new or established, large, medium or small. We want to taste the wines of producers who push the boundaries and are uncompromising in their quest for quality, and we have yet to be disappointed. A huge thank you to everyone who enters the WineGB Awards, I feel so lucky and privileged to judge this competition."

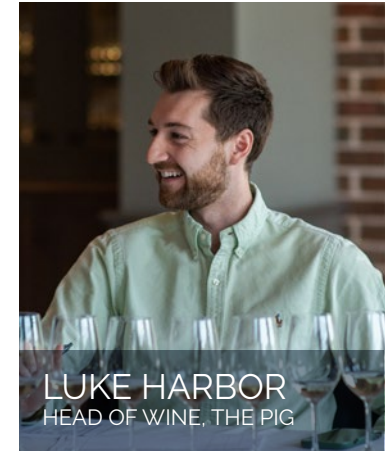

"It doesn't need me to tell you that our climate is changing in a most dramatic way. Not that this isn't both a blessing and a serious challenge. Our judging week at Exton Park in Hampshire was for the fourth year in a row marked by blissfully cloudless skies. Would all of June be the same? Not entirely. Two big thunderstorm events brought reality back into focus just as growers were dreaming about their vines flowering perfectly. In a maritime climate, we have always expected our heatwaves to be broken by storms. Yet Doctor Alistair Nesbitt's 2022 Report on climate change between now and 2040 makes for arresting reading. A majority of our vintage years will be like 2018?? What an opportunity! What a challenge! And we're seeing this already in the wines we judge. More Chardonnays than ever, of a higher quality than ever. More Pinot Noirs of medal quality than ever before, managing to marry ripeness with a truly English elegance. I say 'English' - Wales won a gold medal for Pinot Noir! In sparkling wines, a mouthwatering variety of styles are now being made to world class standards, both lees-aged and classic, as well as lively, vivacious and youthful - and even red! Established wineries and vineyards continue to get better. But we judges get such a thrill when we realise we've given medals to wineries we didn't know, and it's really rewarding to think we're setting them on the path to greater things. We have a wine nation that has barely begun to exploit its potential. Every year we have more growers and winemakers brimming over with imagination and ambition. Every year new areas of Britain stand up proud and say - we can do it too. We have the chance in the next generation to become one of the world's greatest cool climate wine nations. And this year's Awards competition shows that we're going about it in the right way."

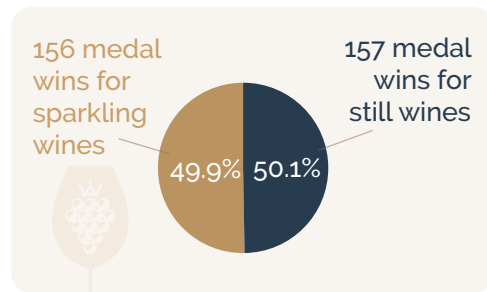
The Judges



Competition highlights

346 wines submitted, of which 313 won medals

- A total of **48 gold, 145 silver, 120 bronze medals** were awarded (compared to 2022 - 36 gold, 114 silver and 141 bronze)
- There were a **record number of entries**, with **111 producers entering**, 18 of these for the first time
- There were **157 wins for still wines and 156 for sparkling wine**
- **90% of wines entered gained a medal**; this was similar to 2021 and 2022, in which 89% of wines gained a medal
- All regions gained awards

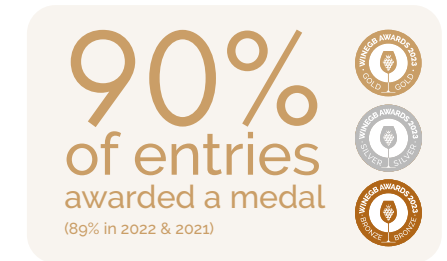
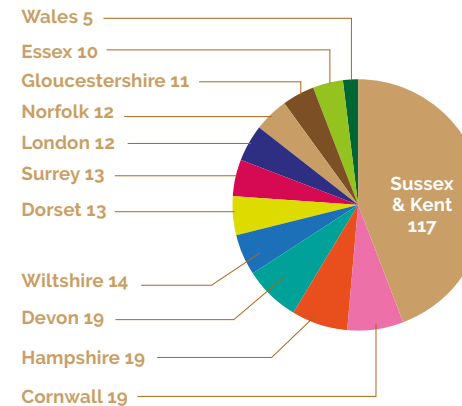
Notable wins

- Five gold medals for **Gusbourne**, three for **Langham Wine Estate**, **Chapel Down** and **Bluebell Vineyard Estates**
- **Smaller producers scooping gold medals**: All Angels for their Classic Cuvée 2017 (Berkshire), and two Wiltshire producers: first-time entrant **Domaine Hugo's Hugo 2019** and **Southcott Vineyard's 2018 Classic**
- **First time entrants Nania's Vineyard** awarded silver for their canned still Orange Ortega
- Silver medals for **Trevibban Mill** and **Vagabond Wines** for their **Pet Nat** wines
- Golds awarded to Welsh producer **White Castle** and South West's **Sandridge Barton** for **Pinot Noir** reds
- **Blackbook Winery** – an urban winery in Battersea, London wins a **gold for a Chardonnay**

Outstanding Chardonnays

- **Chardonnay triumphed** in the still wine category, scooping six of the ten gold still wine medals
- **Bacchus**, a popular variety, was awarded **23% of all still medal winning wines**, the majority from the 2022 vintage
- **Pinot Noir** reds also showed well with two gold medals amongst the 14 gained overall
- **Rosé** as a style gained **23% of all medals awarded to stills** (36 medals), 28 of which are 2022 vintage - and included a gold medal

Notable medal wins by county



Vintage Classic Cuvée takes the most medals

- **Vintage Classic Cuvée** proved to be the standout class, taking **38 medals**; from 2013 to 2020 vintages
- Of the two sparkling reds entered, one gained a **gold medal**
- **Blanc de Blancs: 33 gained medals** (21% of those awarded to sparkling - 10.5% of all medals - 9 golds (nearly 30% of the Blanc de Blanc medal category and nearly 19% of all golds awarded)
- **Sparkling Rosé took 34 medals** (22% of all medals) and scooped six of the 38 sparkling golds (16%)
- **149 of 156 sparkling wines entered were classic method**; seven were produced by other method
- **Blanc de Noirs: 16 medals** gained including **six golds** (over 30% of the category); 16% of all medals awarded to sparkling; 12.5% of all golds awarded overall
- **Non-traditional method** sparkling wines also saw medal success for **Charmat-produced wines** and an aerated **Bacchus**
- The **Innovation category** saw a larger range of entries and medal wins this year, demonstrating the dynamism of the sector.
