





# TARGET CONSUMER DISTRIBUTION

Primarily concentrated in and around Altrincham/ Wilmslow/ Alderley Edge (Golden Triangle) and Chester


Secondary (*smaller*) clusters in Liverpool, Greater Manchester and Shrewsbury.









# RESTAURANTS



623 restaurants\* within 60 minutes' drive of DA13 OXE.

Most popular cuisines: Italian (207), Pizzeria (88), British (75), Mediterranean (55), Greek (42).





# ENGLISH HERITAGE AND NATIONAL TRUST



In total, Cheshire has **4** **English Heritage** sites, 26<sup>th</sup> most by county.



The closest English Heritage site to Tilston is Beeston Castle and Woodland Park (19- minute drive), a 13<sup>th</sup> Century castle thought to be the hiding place of Richard II's treasure. Slightly further is Chester Roman Amphitheatre (24'), the largest of its kind in Britain.



**14%** of target households have National Trust memberships\* (compared to 10% of all households in England).




In total, Cheshire has **7** **National Trust** properties, 28<sup>th</sup> most by county.



# RAIL CONNECTIONS

*Closest station*  
to Tilston is Wrexham Central (10.7 miles or approx. 22-minute drive), which handles 42,000 journeys per year and is classified as “Small Unstaffed”. Connections to Wrexham General in 6 minutes.

*Chester Station*  
4,122,000 passengers travel to/ from Chester Station per year, with the most popular connection being with Liverpool Lime Street. Connections to Crewe and Manchester also connect Chester with Birmingham, London and other UK cities.

*Main operators*  
in Northwest England are: Northern Trains (241 stations) and Merseyrail (66).

*Consider signage / advertising*  
opportunities onboard Northern/ Merseyrail services, and at stations connecting with Wrexham Central/ General and Chester (i.e., Liverpool Lime Street, Crewe, Stockport).
